| <p>DECORATE AN EGG</p> <p>Decorate an egg for Easter. You could draw an egg, decorate the shell of a real egg, chalk an egg outside on the patio, print an egg using a potato masher Be as creative as you like.</p> | <p>SWEET TREATS</p> <p>People celebrate Easter by eating chocolate, buns, cakes. Try making a sweet treat to share with your family. Take a photo of what you made. You could even write and illustrate the recipe.</p> |
| <p>SPRING ANIMALS</p> <p>Create a spring picture of chicks and rabbits. Finger print the bodies and add details.</p>  | <p>EASTER BASKET</p> <p>Make and decorate a basket to hold the Easter treats you made. You could use a bucket, empty cardboard box, paper plate...</p> |
| <p>SIGNS OF SPRING</p> <p>Go on a hunt for signs of spring. Look in your garden or on your daily walk. How many signs can you see?</p> <p>You could: Make a list, take some photos, create a spring picture to show what you have found.</p> | <p>EASTER PARADE</p> <p>Make an Easter bonnet. You could encourage other family members to join in and hold an Easter parade.</p> |
| <p>EASTER HUNT</p> <p>Make up an Easter hunt for your family. You will need to think of some clues for them to follow and hide something at the end. Maybe the sweet treats you have made!</p> | <p>E for EGG</p> <p>Egg starts with 'e'. What else starts with 'e'?</p> <p>Make a collection of things from around your house/garden.</p> <p>Make a list. Choose another letter/sound and make another collection.</p> |
| <p>PLANTS</p> <p>Plant a bulb or some seeds. Keep a diary to show what happens. If you don't have any seeds/bulbs you could try placing the top of a vegetable like a carrot in a plate of water – see what happens.</p>  | <p>AN EASTER POEM</p> <p>Choose one of these words and write an acrostic poem: SPRING, EASTER, EGG. The first letter of each line will spell out your chosen word.</p> <p>Everyone celebrating Easter All the chicks are hatching Spring is here The children hunt for Easter eggs Eggs are eaten Rabbits hopping in the sun</p> |
